"Columbia River Treaty Review"

The Columbia River Treaty is an international agreement between Canada and the United States of America. It has served as a model of international cooperation since 1964, bringing significant flood control and power generation benefits to both countries. It also required sacrifice and compromise to succeed.

The year 2024 is significant for the treaty as it marks the end of 60 years of pre-paid flood control space from Canada. The United States or Canada can terminate most provisions of the Treaty anytime on or after September 16, 2024. With a minimum 10 years' written notice. The USACE and BPA are conducting a multi-year effort to study post 2014- Treaty issues, known as the 2014/2024 Columbia Treaty Review.

Come hear a conversation between some of the main participants in the studies and planning. What does this mean to the Pacific Northwest and what are the implications for Idaho? What lessons could be learned by other nations confronted with development and protection of a shared resource?
