














IDAWRA: "Boise River Management in 2017 "





Weather conditions in the Boise River Basin from fall 2016 into early summer 2017 combined to produce runoff exceeding all but the most extreme years on record. Managing the distribution of flow from the upper basin to the lower basin to minimize damage in the urbanized valley, while preserving water in storage for summer irrigation, required careful forecasting and frequent adjustments of dam releases. A few days of hot weather could have brought a catastrophe. A constant challenge to past practices, the runoff season seemed to never end.

Speakers: Mary Mellema recently retired , having worked for the Bureau of Reclamation Pacific Northwest Regional Office River and Reservoir Operations group since 2001. She was the supervisor of the real-time reservoir operations group and her tasks include directing daily operations and water management for Reclamation reservoirs across the Pacific Northwest including the Boise River.
